

Youth Access to Tobacco Prevention Act of 2006

Purchasing, attempting to purchase, possessing or attempting to possess tobacco products as a minor (under age 18) is subject to:

- A civil fine of \$25;
- Completion of a SC DHEC approved **smoking cessation** or tobacco prevention program; or
- Completion of not more than 5 hours of **community service** for a charitable institution

If a minor fails to pay the fine, attend a smoking cessation program or complete community service hours, the court can:

- **Restrict** the minor's driver's license for 90 days
- **Delay** the issuance of the minor's driver's license for 90 days
- **Notify the parents** of the minor of the restriction or delayed issuance of the minor's drivers license or permit
